INFORMATIONS:

- The categories can start +-30 minutes before or after the official scheduled time.
- The official competition schedule will be available on the websites before the competition – sportdata.org, karate.sk
- Weigh-in will be mandatory for all kumite categories.
- Weigh-in will be before first rounds in each kumite categories on the tatami.
- Weight tolerance for categories of younger cadets, cadets, juniors, U21 and seniors is max. 2,99 kg, including all the equipment - properly dressed in karate gi, with a belt and all protectors.
- Weight tolerance for categories of children up to 11 years of age is max. 1,99 kg, including all the equipment - properly dressed in karate gi, with a belt and all protectors.
- Helmet (white with plexiglass) are mandatory for all kumite children categories and U14.

The detailed competition schedule will be fixed after closing the online registration in order to adequate it to the final number of athletes.

In case in kumite categories of less than 6 competitors we will use round-robin system.

Number of Kata required:

In categories cadet, junior, U21, senior in principle a Competitor have to perform a different kata for each round (from WKF list). However, no more than five (5) different kata are required to complete a competition. If the number of participants require a sixth round to win, a kata previously performed may be repeated (only in this sixth bout/match) as long as no kata is repeated twice in succession, one round after the other. The same principle should be applied if a seventh round is required to win.

For competition under 14 years (U14 = 12-13 yo) of age no more than four (4) kata is required (WKF list), and above rule of repetition will apply from the fifth round with further repetitions allowed along the same principle for subsequent rounds.

For competition under 12 years (U12 = 10-11 yo) of age no more than three (3) kata is required (WKF list + basic katas), and above rule of repetition will apply from the fourth round with further repetitions allowed along the same principle for subsequent rounds.

For competition for those under 10 years (U10 + U8 = 8-9 + 6-7 yo) of age no more than two (2) kata is required (WKF list + basic katas), and above rule of repetition will apply from the third round with further repetitions allowed along the same principle for subsequent rounds.

Each Competitor is free to select which kata to use for each round provided that the relevant kata is announced for each round and follow the above rules from repetition. The possibility of repeating kata is an opinion and do not prevent any Competitor to perform a new kata for each round regardless of the number of rounds required to win.

A bye in a competition (free round or seated, or an unrepresented competitor) does not mean that the kata was performed. The number of performed kata is considered to be the actual kata executed in specific matches.
